## Tea Selection

### DRAGON PEARL JASMINE (SCENTED GREEN TEA)

*Region: Guangxi Province, China*

Dragon Pearl Jasmine, also known as "Buddha Tears" are scented six times with Jasmine blossoms to produce a rich and distinctive floral fragrance. Hot water during the infusion unravels each hand-rolled tea pearl and releases its sweet Jasmine floral flavour that lingers into a pleasantly persistent long after-taste.

### DRAGON WELL (GREEN TEA)

*Region: Zhejiang Province, China*

Dragon Well or 'Long Ching' is arguably the most famous Chinese green tea gaining imperial status in the Qing Dynasty. Each handpicked leaf is pan-fired by skilled tea masters from techniques handed down from centuries ago. Delicate craftsmanship produces smooth flattened leaves with a refreshing green, buttery, crisp taste.

### PU ERH (BLACK TEA)

*Region: Yunnan Province, China*

Full-bodied fermented tea brewing a dark and glossy liquor in appearance. Each sip produces a mellow smooth earthy flavour with a subtle hint of smoky aromas in after taste. Pu Erh is commonly referred to as the "wine of tea" and our current selection has been aged for 6 years to develop its current refined smooth flavour.

### BIG RED ROBE (OOLONG TEA)

*Region: Fujian Province, China*

The "coffee lover's" tea. Produced from the original bushes in the Wuyi mountains - also the world's most expensive tea. This prestigious tea smoothly fills the palate with its refined complexity of rocky minerals, roasted nutty fragrances and a hint of smokiness.

### IRON GODDESS (GREEN TEA)

*Region: Anxi Province, China*

'Tie Guan Yin', named after the Chinese Goddess of Mercy is smooth and subtle in flavour. Each sip is sweet and refreshing, with a subtle release of delicate floral aromas filling your palate leaving a pleasant soothing and relaxing after taste. 'Tie Guan Yin', from the Anxi province, is recognised as one of the top 10 most famous teas of China.
